10. ENTRIES

A total of 16 boys and 16 girls qualify for the 2016 ITTF World Junior Circuit Finals; subject to the following criteria:

- i. Players must have competed in junior singles a minimum of two continents in tournaments on the 2016 ITTF World Junior Circuit.
- ii. A maximum of two players are eligible from any national association; should three or more players from a national association occupy qualified places, it is the responsibility of the national association to nominate the player or players for the ITTF World Junior Circuit Finals.
- iii. The nine highest listed players on the Junior Boys' and Junior Girls' Standings following the concluding tournament on the 2016 ITTF World Junior Circuit calendar (the Portugal Junior and Cadet Open) qualify.
 - If two or more players finish with equal points in the ITTF World Junior Circuit Standings, the final order is determined by the highest number of points recorded in any one tournament on the ITTF World Junior Circuit in 2016.
 - Should there still be equality the next highest finish and so on is taken into consideration.
 - In the unlikely event of there still being equality, the ITTF Under 18 World Ranking current at the time of the publication of the final 2016 ITTF Junior Circuit Standings (November 2016 ITTF WR) will be the determining factor.
- iv. The highest listed player from each continent –Africa, Asia, Europe, Latin America, North America, Oceania– on the final Standings for the year qualifies for the Finals.
 - If no player from the continent has competed in two or more continents on the 2016 ITTF Junior Circuit, the place is awarded to the highest listed player from that continent on the final Standings, regardless of appearances.
- v. If a continent has players qualified for the Finals because of the position on the final Standings, the place is awarded to the next eligible player on the final Standings.
- vi. A Wild Card is allocated to the host association.
 - If the host has player or players qualified by other means; the host must advise who receives the entry by qualification and who receives the Wild Card.

11. FORMAT OF PLAY:

FIRST STAGE:

All matches will be played to the best of seven (7) games.

Initially the 16 boys and 16 girls are drawn in four groups with four players in each group competing on a Round-Robin basis. The draw is completed using a modified snake system (two by two). Players from the same association shall be drawn in different groups.

SECOND STAGE:

All matches will be played to the best of seven (7) games in both Main Draw and Consolation.

A) MAIN DRAW

The players finishing in first and second places in each group progress to the quarter-finals.

Procedure for the quarter-final draw is as follows:

- Winner of group 1 shall be *placed* in position 1 in the main draw
- Winner of group 2 shall be *placed* in position 8 in the main draw

- Winners of the groups 3-4 shall be *drawn* in positions 4-5 in the main draw (subject to Association separation)
- The second placed players in each group shall be *drawn* in opposite halves to the first placed players (from the same group) - positions 2, 3, 6 & 7 (this takes precedence over separation by Association)
- Finally, separation by Association if possible
- There will be no matches for positions in the Main Draw.

B) CONSOLATION

The remaining players will progress to the consolation event.

Procedure for the consolation knock-out stage draw:

- Players in third position each group shall be drawn into positions 1, 4, 5 & 8 (subject to Association separation)
- Players in fourth position in each group shall be drawn in opposite halves to the third placed players (from the same group) - positions 2, 3, 6 & 7 (this takes precedence over separation by Association)
- Finally, separation by Association if possible
- There will be no matches for positions in the Consolation.

12. SEEDING AND DRAW:

- The **Delegates Meeting** will be held on Wednesday 25th January 2017, at 16:00 hours in the Meeting Room at the Best Western Plus Hotel, followed by the **first stage draw**. Seeding for both events will use the 2016 year-ending ITTF World Ranking U-18.
- The **second stage draws** will be conducted on Friday 27th January 2017, 10 minutes after the end of the first stage group for the girls' and for boys' event at the Meeting Room in the Venue.

17. HOSPITALITY:

The ITTF and the Organizing Committee offer hospitality from **lunch on Wednesday 25th January to breakfast on Sunday 29th January for all qualified players**. Accommodation is provided in a double occupancy basis (players from geographically near associations allocated together) or with their accompanying coaches if expressly requested by the associations (accommodation for coaches at a charge).

Participants will be welcomed at the **Indore International Airport** (Devi Ahilyabai Holkar Airport). IATA CODE: **IDR**

Accompanying persons/extra days will be charged as follows:

The hotel has a very limited number of rooms offered additional to those for official party. Based on availability (first come, first served), extra persons/days will be accepted and charged as follows:

Hospitality: Accommodation at the official hotel and three meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner at the hotel) plus accreditation and airport/hotel transport (full hospitality package) is offered at the price of USD:140.00 for a single room. For double occupancy USD 110 per player per day based on availability. Same rates apply for any extra night.

18. VISA REQUIREMENTS:

Visitors to India may need visa.

For those requiring visas, the Organizing Committee will assist with the application process but applicants must be punctual. Please submit the document attached with the entry form and contact the Organizing Committee, as soon as possible, if you need a visa for India.

19. TRAVEL AND HEALTH INSURANCE:

Each participating player and accompanying person is requested to make their own travel and health insurance arrangements.

20. AWARDS:

Winners, runners up and semi-finalist will receive medals; winners will also receive trophies.
