Indian players have won 1 Gold, 2 Silver and 4 Bronze medals. The championship held from 19th – 25th May 2009 at Glasgow. The following players represented India:

1. Men's Team – Won Silver Medal lost to Singapore in finals.
2. Women's Team – Won Bronze Medal.
3. Men's Singles, Achanta Sharath Kamal – Silver Medal lost to Gao Ning of Singapore.
4. Men's Singles, Subhajit Saha – Won Bronze Medal lost to team mate Achanta Sharath Kamal in semi-finals.
5. Women's Singles, Mouma Das – Won Bronze Medal.
6. Men's Doubles, Achanta Sharath Kamal and Subhajit Saha - Won Gold Medal in finals, they beat Gao Ning and Yang zi of Singapore (Top seed).
7. Mixed Doubles, A Amalraj and Madhurika Suhas Patkar – Won Bronze Medal.

In the last Commonwealth Championships in 2007 at Jaipur, India won one Silver medal in Men's Team, One Bronze Medal in Women's Team and one Bronze Medal in Men's Singles.

In Commonwealth Games in 2006 India won 3 medals i.e. in Men's Singles and Men's Team event one Gold medal each and one Bronze Medal in Women's Team.

India has improved from 3 medals to 7 medals.
