

THE TABLE TENNIS FEDERATION OF INDIA
Regulations for conducting the All India Inter-Institutional Table Tennis Championships-2008

1. Entry Fee payable to the Federation in respect of the championships is Rs. 500/-
2. Entry Fees of Rs. 50/- per head per event will be charged for the open events from such of those players who are not members of the team. Such entry fees are payable alongwith the entries.
3. The entry fee as per 1 & 2 above should be remitted to the federation office, New Delhi alongwith entry form and is not refundable.
4. **Boarding & Lodging Charges:** Participating Institutions will make their own arrangements for boarding and lodging for their team members. In case any Institution desires that arrangements for boarding and lodging should be made by the host Institution a request in writing should be made well in advance and the charges for the same should be paid to the host Institution/Association.
5. All events shall be held under the laws and appropriate regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation as adopted by the Table Tennis Federation of India.
6. **Team Event:** The competition shall be conducted in two stages.
Stage 1-All the team shall be divided into four groups i.e. A,B,C and D and shall play in round robin league basis.
Stage2- The Draw will be taken out for the II stage as follows.
In the II Stage the winner of group A and B will be placed in draw position 1 and 8, the winner of group C and D will be drawn between position 4 and 5. The runners up will be drawn in the remaining places in opposite halves from the winners of the same groups.

All the Matches in the team Championships shall be played best of 5 games of 11 points each.

Team Match System:

- (1) A team shall consist of 3 players.
- (2) The order to play shall be A v/s X, B v/s Y, C v/s Z, A v/s Y, B v/s X.

7. Individual Events:

Singles Events: All singles events shall be conducted on knock-out system. All matches in singles events shall be played best of seven games of 11 points in the main draw. Whereas all the qualifying matches shall be played best of five games of 11 points each.

Doubles Events: Doubles events shall be conducted on the knock out system. All matches in Doubles events shall be played best of five games of 11 points each.

8. The following shall be entitled for entries:

All the affiliated (who are not in arrear) Institutions shall be eligible to enter one team each in Men's & Women's Team Championships.

Each team shall consist a maximum of 5 and a minimum of 3 players in Men & Women's team. All the States & Institutions may nominate maximum of two entries in Men's Doubles, two entries in Women's Doubles & 4 entries in Mixed Doubles.

All the states will also be eligible to send the entries in the Men's & Women's Singles event as per their entitlement in the National Championships.

9. The open events of the Inter-Institutional championships will be treated at par with Zonal Championships. Players of State Associations are also eligible to participate in the open events and the player's performance will be reckoned for ranking.

10. The participants in the championships will have to find their own conveyance from their lodge to the playing arena and back.
11. The complete draw and programme for the championships will be put on the Notice board at the venue and shall serve as the only official intimation to the competitors regarding the programme and time of play. All authentic information regarding the championships can be had from the Organising secretary of the Championships.
12. All umpiring will be done in English Language only.
13. In view of organizational difficulties, the order of play will not be altered even if the captains mutually agree, unless it has the final approval and consent of the referee and the Organising Secretary.
14. The Captains of the team scheduled to play at a particular time, shall report to the Chief Referee or his appointed deputy at least Ten Minutes before the time fixed for their matches and team not present at the time scheduled for its match is liable to concede a walk-over to its opponents.
Any complaint or appeal on any point of law may be made only by the Captain or if he is absent or playing, by authorised representative of the team.
15. Entries will be accepted only through affiliated Institution/State Association of the Table Tennis Federation of India. Direct entries from Individual players will not be accepted.
16. Each Institution should pay affiliation fee of Rs.12000/- per year which falls due in the month of April every year.
17. Entries will not be accepted from such of those Institutions which have not:
 1. Complied with the rules and Regulations of the TTFI in respect of Affiliation Fees, Associate Fees and in the conduct of open tournaments and / or annual championships.
 2. Paid all the arrears and have not complied with the decisions of General Council Meeting of the TTFI held in previous years.
18. Chief Referee, Deputy Referee, Assistant Referee and Umpires will be nominated by the Federation whom Host Association / Institutions will provide free Lodging & Boarding, Transport and Pocket expenses as per the rules of the Federation.
19. The Host Association will pay Royalty of Rs. 50,000/- for the conduct of the this event to the Federation.
20. Tables and Balls will be provided by the Federation. The Transport Charges for Tables for both side, will be borne by the Host Association. Tables will be sent back to the manufacturer after conclusion of the championships. Balls will be provided by the Federation on cost.
21. Proper Transport arrangement may be made from Hotel to Venue and back if it is more than 1 km.
22. Medal's will be arranged by the Host Association / TTFI.

23. Trophies will be sent by the Federation.
24. Proper Medical Facilities should be provided at the venue.
25. Presentation of Trophies and Medals will be decided by the Federation in consultation with the Host Association.
26. Chief Guest for the Opening and Closing Ceremonies will be fixed by the TTFI in consultation with the Host Association.
27. Chairman Technical Committee/Selection Committee/Chairman Classification Committee/Executive Committee Members/ State Association Secretaries will be provided Free Hospitality during the championships.
28. Technical Committee / Chairman Classification Committee will be paid TA & DA as per rules of TTFI.
29. President /Secretary / Treasurer of the Federation will be paid travelling expenses by Air /Train 1st AC and Free Boarding and Lodging in a Star Hotel by the Host Association.
30. Proper facilities for the Media persons should be arranged and the Host Association shall arranged press conference 7 days before commencement of the championships.
31. The Draw will be held at TTFI Office. The expenses of the Technical Committee / Chief Referee and Chairman Classification Committee will be borne by the Host Association.
32. One separate car should be arranged at the disposal of the Chairman Technical Committee, President, Secretary and Treasurer of the Federation if they visit.
