VISA / EO ENTRY PROCEDURES

GENERAL: By entering the event all acknowledge and agree that they shall comply with the WTT rules, regulations, policies and additional requirements and procedures as issued by WTT.

VISA: Please complete ALL visa information needed in the WTT OES no later than 1 FEBRUARY 2026 to obtain a letter of invitation. For any visa related enquiries, please contact marcin.fidala@pzts.pl

Entry to Host Country: All participants are responsible for adhering to the border entry requirements - Link to local government regulations.

EVENT ENTRY DETAILS, TRAVEL/INSURANCE & TROPHY PRESENTATIONS

HOSPITALITY: The EO reserves the right to move participants from the Official Hospitality Packages to the Accreditation option, in case the Member Association doesn't provide accommodation/travel details prior to the respective deadlines. First comes first serves policy is applied in case one of the Official Hospitality Options is fully booked. In case needed, the EO reserves the right to accommodate the participants at another hotel(s) (same level or higher level; same accommodation rates included on this prospectus).

TRAVEL: Player's participation at the Event is not confirmed prior to the entry deadline. We strongly recommend to not book flight tickets (or book refundable/flexible tickets) prior to getting the participation confirmation email from the WTT Event Supervisor, Transfers between airport/train to the hotel are provided only on the check-in and check-out dates.

INSURANCE: By entering the event, each Member Association must ensure that all the participants have medical, travel and other appropriate insurance.

CHANGES: Changes between subevents are not permitted after the entry deadline.

PARTICIPANTS: All participants for the Event (including coaches, ACC, Medical, Delegates) must be entered through the WTT OES. Accreditations and visa invitation letters are not provided to individuals not entered in the OES.

TROPHY PRESENTATION: Champions and finalists must attend the trophy presentations.

NEW PLAYERS REGISTRATION: The registration of new players, who never participated in a WTT/ITTF Event, and respective participation forms must be submitted not less than seven (7) days prior to the entry deadline. Player Registration Guide is available here

ENTRY RESTRICTIONS, CANCELLATION PENALTIES & PAYMENTS

Cancellation Fees:

- Participants in Entry Fee option:
 - Non-Players: Those who cancel the participation will be required to pay USD 150 per person
 - Players: Those who cancel the participation before 17 FEBRUARY 2026 20:00 SGT (UTC+8:00) will be required to pay USD 150 per person Players: Those who cancel the participation after 17 FEBRUARY 2026 20:00 SGT (UTC+8:00) or no show will be required to pay USD 225 per person
 - Entry fee is not required to pay in case of cancellation.
- Participants in Official Hospitality Package:
 - Those who cancel the participation before 17 FEBRUARY 2026 20:00 SGT (UTC+8:00) will be required to pay USD 150 per person. Those who cancel the participation after 17 FEBRUARY 2026 20:00 SGT (UTC+8:00) will be required to pay USD 150+1 night in Single room per
 - Those who cancel the participation after 24 FEBRUARY 2026 23:59 (local time) or no show will be required to pay Full board hospitality.

Payments:

- Cancellations after the entry deadline are subject to cancellation penalty fees (applicable to players and non-players).
- Payments must be done prior the event start by bank transfer. For payments in cash, please contact marcin.fidala@pzts.pl.
- Event Organisers have the right to decline issuance of accreditation until initial payment of entry or hospitality invoices has been settled.
- Event Organisers have the right to apply a surcharge of up to 5% on hospitality or accreditation packages for those late in submitting details past the respective deadlines as indicated on the Event Prospectus.
- Event Organisers have the right to apply 5% interest after the payment due date of an invoice. This fee will increase up to 20% if payment has still not been received 30 days after the initial payment due date.
- Event Organisers have the right to charge the full transportation fee when there is official transport between events in case of cancelation after the travel details deadline.

National Entry Restriction

- In case schedule doesn't permit to accept all the players, the Event Supervisor will contact the Member Associations to the necessary adjustments per event.
- In case restrictions are needed, the Host is entitled to enter a minimum of 6 players per subevent per gender.

Player Entry Restriction

- 2 singles subevents per player (consecutive age categories)
- Players confirmed in Singles are entitled to play Mixed Doubles (limited to one age category)

Replacements

Only replacements in same subevents are permitted.
