ACCREDITATION TERMS

- For players, if the accreditation option as the only option is not selected in the OES any player entered by the Singles Deadline will automatically be considered as registered under this option
- Event Organisers have the right to decline issuance of accreditation until initial payment of entry or hospitality invoices has been settled.
- Event Organisers have the right to apply a surcharge of up to 5% on accreditation packages for those late in submitting details past the respective deadlines as indicated on the Event Prospectus.
- Event Organisers have the right to apply 5% interest after the payment due date of an invoice. This fee will increase up to 20% if payment has still not been received 30 days after the initial payment due date.
- Event Organisers have the right to accept or decline requests from MAs/participants to issue separate invoices. If the request comes not later than 3 days after the hospitality deadline a surcharge of up to USD 15 per invoice shall be charged, if the EO agrees to issue them.

ENTRY RESTRICTIONS & CANCELLATION PENALTIES

Top 50 Participation Restrictions (PDR)

Singles events

- Players inside the Top 30 of the ITTF TTWR, at the time of the entry deadline, are not permitted to participate in WTT Feeder Series events. However, a maximum of two (2) players will be permitted to participate if they are from the host Member Association.
- A maximum of six (6) players ranked between 31 and 50 in the ITTF TTWR, at the time of the entry deadline, may participate in WTT Feeder Series events with priority given to players from the host Member Association.

National Entry Restriction

Singles events

- A maximum of eight (8) players per Member Association across both Main Draw and Qualifying competition (where organised) with unrestricted entries for the host will be permitted to participate.
- Where a Qualifying competition is undersubscribed additional players from Member Associations will be accepted into the Qualifying, based on the ITTF TTWR to fill the available spots.

Doubles & Mixed Doubles events

- A maximum of six (6) players per Member Association (up to 3 all nation pairs) and ten (10) players for the host (up to 5 all nation pairs) will be permitted to participate across Main Draw and Qualifying competition when exists. A maximum of four (4) players per Member Association (up to 2 full nation pairs) and eight (8) players for the host (up to 4 all nation pairs) will be permitted to participate in Main Draw in case there is no Qualifying.
- Where a Qualifying or a Main Draw competition is undersubscribed additional pairs from Member Associations will be accepted, based on the ITTF TTWR to fill the available spots.

Wildcards

- The host is entitled to the following Wildcards: four (4) players for the Singles Main Draw and two (2) pairs for the Doubles and Mixed Doubles Main Draw.
- WTT reserves the right to use two (2) WTT Youth Nominations for the Singles Main Draw and two (2) WTT Youth Nominations for the Singles Qualifying Draw.
- Any unused Host Wildcards/WTT Youth Nominations will be returned to the direct entries.

Cancellation Penalties

- Cancellations penalties as per the WTT Handbook will apply.
